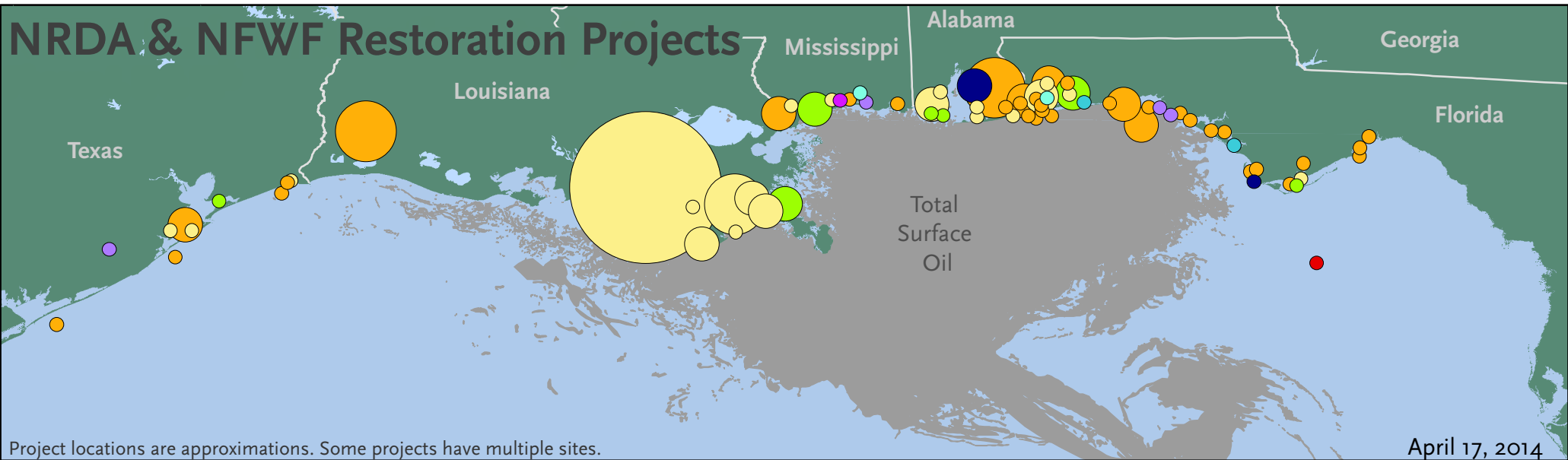

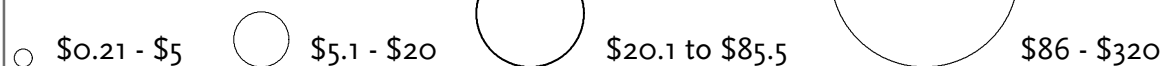

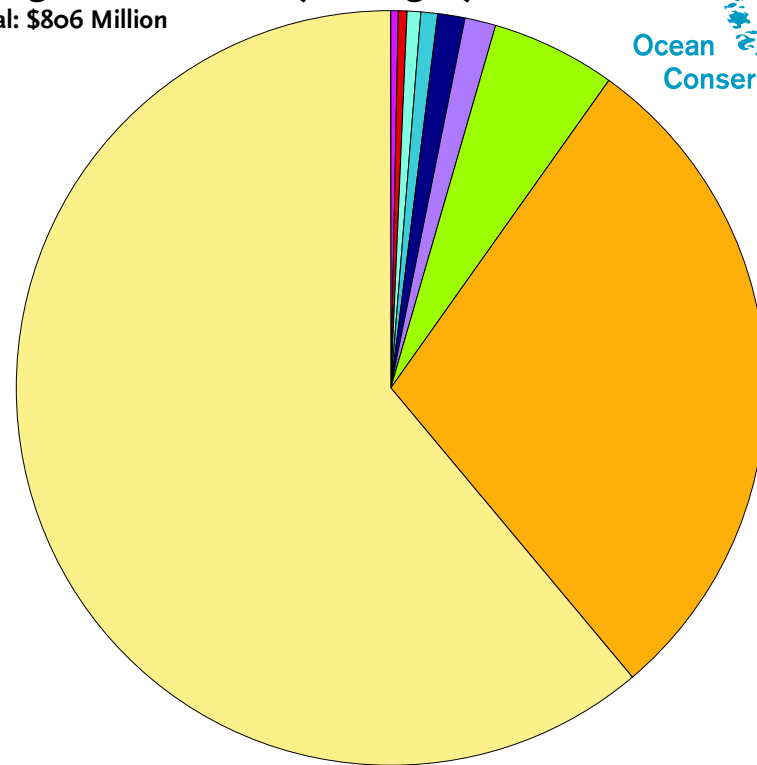
Project Budgets
